centrair Chubu Centrair International Airport Japan's Only "Theme Park" Airport

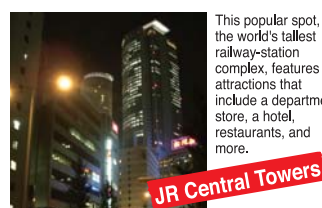
Centrair features a shopping zone that redefines the concept of airports. With a design that re-creates a townscape of feudal Japan, this airport is practically a theme park.



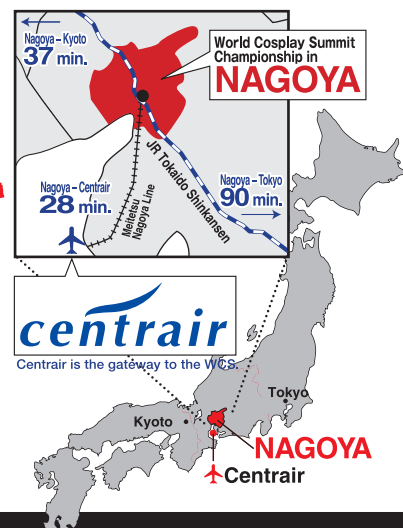
