1. Representative cosplayers from each country are to consist of 1 team of 2 people.
2. Cosplays are to be from Japanese manga and anime. (At the preliminary rounds, costumes from Japanese games are permitted. However, at the Cosplay Championship that is held in Japan, only costumes from Japanese manga and anime are allowed; costumes from games are prohibited.
3. Costumes are to be handmade. Ready-made or off-the-shelf goods are prohibited.
 - It is preferable that costumes are hand-made by the contestants themselves, but it is permissible for family and friends to help.
 - Purchase and then re-making of ready-made or off-the-shelf goods to use in costumes is permissible.

4. The World Cosplay Summit includes both the Cosplay Parade and the Cosplay Championship. The Cosplay Championship is a contest to decide the world's number one cosplayers. At the contest, representatives from each participating country perform on stage within a time limit of 3 minutes.

5. In order to take part in the World Cosplay Summit, you must be able to come to Japan for about 1 week at the end of July/beginning of August.

6. We ask for your positive cooperation in making the cosplay summit a success. There will be various media events aside from the parade and the contest.

7. Three costumes are needed when in Japan: a parade costume, a contest costume, and clothes for any media events.

- If this is not possible, a minimum of 2 costumes is okay

8. Team costumes at the Cosplay Championship are to be characters from the same Japanese manga (or Japanese anime). (For example, Goku from "Dragonball" and Sesshoumaru from "Inu Yasha" cannot be performed at the same time by 1 team).

- At the preliminary rounds, it is possible to perform as characters from different Japanese anime or manga.
- It is possible to give different performances at the preliminary round and at the Cosplay Championship. However, if the performance is the same as that done at the preliminary round, the level of the performance must be improved.
- Costumes worn at the parade do not have to be from the same manga (or Japanese anime or games).

9. Music for performances is to be prepared individually. Documents stating what kind of performance will be given are to be submitted in advance.

10. Participants must be 18 years old and over.

- If a participant is under 18, it is possible to take part if he/she can obtain permission from their parents, and can come to Japan alone.

11. If costumes to be brought to Japan are heavy and luggage is deemed to be overweight, the cost of this extra luggage will be borne by the individual.

It is possible to send things to Japan in advance, but the cost of this will be borne by the individual. Please take this into account when preparing your costumes.

12. When documents are requested by the sponsor (TV Aichi) regarding the World Cosplay Summit, please prepare and submit them immediately.

13. For prior announcements of the World Cosplay Summit, images and photos from the preliminary rounds will be used in the media (TV shows, homepages on the web, newspapers, magazines, etc) but no remuneration will be given.

14. Image rights in all media exposure such as news gathering from TV programs and other assorted media involved with the World Cosplay Summit, promotional activities in the print media, as well as events and performances, and announcements both prior to and during your stay in Japan of the Cosplay Summit, will be attributed to TV Aichi.

15. After the World Cosplay Summit has finished, images/footage of cosplayers, photographs, programs to be broadcast, internet homepages, DVDs and so on, come under the jurisdiction of TV Aichi. In so doing, no remuneration will be given
